

When will Powerball[®] hold its first Monday drawing?

Powerball[®] will hold its first Monday drawing on August 23, 2021 at 7:45 p.m. This will increase the number of Powerball[®] drawings from two to three nights per week: Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday.

Why is Powerball[®] adding a drawing on Monday nights?

The Powerball[®] Product Group decided to make this change to pick up the pace of the Powerball[®] game. To meet our players' expectations, Powerball is increasing the number of drawings from two to three nights a week. The additional ticket sales from a third weekly drawing are expected to:

- Produce bigger jackpots
- Generate faster-growing jackpots on a weekly basis
- Increase the number of cash prizes and jackpots awarded on an annual basis

Will the additional drawing change the Powerball® game or prize structure?

No. Players will continue to choose five numbers from 1 to 69 and one Powerball[®] number from 1 to 26. The set cash prizes will remain the same.

Does the additional weekly drawing change the odds of winning?

No. Players will still have the same odds of winning a prize, because the two pools of numbers from which the winning numbers are drawn will remain the same (5/69 + 1/26).

What is Double Play[®]?

Double Play[®] is a new add-on feature to the Powerball[®] game. For an additional \$1 per play, players will have a second chance to match their Powerball[®] numbers in a second drawing with a set top cash prize of \$10 million. The Double Play[®] drawing will be held after every Powerball[®] drawing on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday.

When will the Double Play® add-on feature launch?

Players will be able to purchase tickets with Double Play[®] beginning August 22, 2021 for the first drawing to held on Monday, August 23 after the Powerball[®] drawing.

How many lotteries will offer Double Play® when it launches?

Washington is the only state in the Northwest with 12 other lotteries will offer Double Play[®] when it launches on August 23: Colorado, Florida, Indiana, Maryland, Michigan, Missouri, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, South Dakota, and Tennessee. Additional lotteries may choose to offer Double Play[®] at a later date.

Will players have two separate sets of numbers?

No. Players will play the same set of numbers in the Powerball® drawing and Double Play® drawing.

Will Powerball[®] tickets with the Double Play[®] add-on feature be eligible to win prizes in both the Powerball[®] drawing and Double Play[®] drawing?

Yes. Powerball[®] tickets that include the Double Play[®] add-on feature will be eligible to win prizes in both the Powerball[®] drawing and the Double Play[®] drawing.

Will the Power Play[®] add-on feature apply to prizes won in the Double Play[®] drawing?

No. The Power Play[®] add-on feature will only apply to non-jackpot prizes won in the Powerball[®] drawing.

Can a Powerball® ticket include both the Power Play® add-on feature and Double Play® add-on feature?

Yes, a Powerball[®] ticket can include both add-on features for a total price of \$4 per play. Players may also elect to purchase one or none of the add-on features. *Powerball tickets cannot be cancelled. Powerball*[®] - \$2 *Powerball*[®] + *Power Play*[®] - \$3

Powerball® + Double Play® - \$3 Powerball® + Power Play® + Double Play® - \$4

What are the odds for the Double Play®?

Double Play[®] will have the same odds as Powerball[®] since the two pools of numbers from which the winning numbers are drawn are the same (5/69 + 1/26).


Additional Changes

To sell a PowerBall ticket with Double Play, tap on the Powerball button from the home screen.



From the second screen tap the Double Play button so the arrow points to Yes.

You will see the total wager at the bottom of the screen which will be \$3 if a single ticket is selected as a way to verify.
